**AGREED ORDER ON PLAINTIFF'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ORDER
APPROVING SETTLEMENT OF COLLECTIVE ACTION AND AUTHORIZING
NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT AND OPPORTUNITY TO FILE CONSENT TO JOIN AND
RELEASE FORMS, AND DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE**

THIS MATTER came before the Court upon the Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Order Approving Settlement of Collective Action and Authorizing Notice of Settlement and Opportunity to File Consent to Join and Release Forms, and Dismissal with Prejudice (the "Motion"). Having reviewed the Motion and the Settlement Agreement ("Agreement"), and the Court being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:


The Motion is GRANTED. The Court finds that the Parties' Agreement is fair, reasonable and just in all respects.

1. The Parties' Settlement is APPROVED in its entirety.
2. This Action is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE in its entirety.
3. Named Plaintiff's and Qualified Claimants' (as defined in the Agreement) releases of their claims under the Fair Labor Standards Act and any state or other wage and hour

claims in exchange for the consideration provided by Defendant, pursuant to the terms of the Agreement, are hereby APPROVED.

4. The payment to Plaintiffs' Counsel for attorneys' fees and litigation costs is hereby APPROVED.
5. The General Release Payments to the two General Release Payment Recipients in exchange and in consideration for their general releases of all claims against the Released Parties are hereby APPROVED.
6. This Court will RETAIN JURISDICTION to enforce the Settlement.
7. The case is closed and all pending motions are denied as moot.
